The Link+ Can Be Your Personal Life Saver

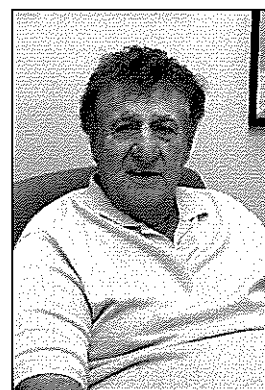

If at any time you need emergency help, all you have to do is press the red button and our 24/7 call center will answer. If you leave the house you can take it with you and wear it around your neck as a necklace or on your wrist. The Link+ also is equipped with fall detection and GPS, a great safety feature.
